

## Publication of Remuneration

The following is an extract from the Trusts 2020/21 accounts for publication purposes in line with the requirement of the Academies Financial Handbook (AFH).

### Trust Context

25 academies across five geographical areas    10,600 pupils    1,500 employees    7.5% reserves    33% (primary) and 41% (secondary) disadvantaged backgrounds    23% (primary) and 6% (secondary) English as an additional language    14% (primary) and 16% (secondary) SEN

The Trust also provides education for almost 3,000 secondary-aged pupils living in Derby and Sheffield. The demographic of the secondary estate shows that the Trust serves communities with higher than average levels of social deprivation.
